# **Open Mic Contest**

## National Gun Violence Awareness Day

- 1. Open to all Leon County middle or high school students.
- 2. Each student may submit one entry per category in up to three of the following categories:
  - a. Poetry
  - b. Prose 500 word maximum
  - c. Music (vocal or instrumental) 5 minute maximum
  - d. Rap 5 minute maximum
- 3. A single selection (one poem, one piece of prose, one song) constitutes an entry.
- 4. The work should address the topic of gun violence, whether it be a personal experience with gun violence, a reaction to gun violence in the community, the news, or the world; or hopes for change related to gun violence in our country.
- 5. Students may submit entries to an English teacher at their school for consideration and feedback before submitting their entry to the contest.
- 6. Students must keep copies of entries as they will not be returned.
- 7. Each entry must include the student's name, school, grade, and contact information (phone number and email)
- 8. Students must submit an Open Mic Contest Entry Form with each entry. Entries should be typed and emailed with the completed form to <u>wearorangetally@gmail.com</u>
- 9. To be eligible for prizes, students must submit their entries no later than May 27 and present their work at the June 2<sup>nd</sup> event.

By submitting the work, you are verifying that it is your authentic, original work. You will receive an acknowledgement via email once your entry has been received and accepted by a committee of secondary English teachers in Leon County. Keep in mind that work you will be presenting on June 2 should be suitable for public performance—there will be families and children present.

You are invited to present your work at the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Wear Orange event at Anita Favors Thompson Plaza on Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10am. There will be an open mic contest with a jury panel from the FSU Department of English and cash prizes will be awarded (\$100-\$50-\$25) to the top three entries. *You must present your work at the June 2<sup>nd</sup> event to be eligible for prizes.*
