Reading Poster Contest Rules and Regulations.

1. Only the slogan "Literacy: Choose Your Adventure" below may be used. See contest rubric.
2. Only original artwork is permitted. Any clip art, tracings, or copyrighted material will not be accepted. Fragile media (pastel, charcoal, etc.) should be sealed with a fixative.
3. **All** poster must be **VERTICAL 12 x 18**, un-matted, and two-dimensional.
4. Each school may submit **ONE** entry. Use the rubric provided to choose your school's selection.
5. Use a mailing tube or mail flat. Creased posters will not be accepted. Please understand that as a non-profit, we will not be able to return any submissions.
6. Fill out the mailing label below and affix to the back of the poster in the lower left corner.
7. The Artwork and Photographic Release Form must be included with every entry.
