WHICH TYPE OF ARTISTS AND VENDORS CAN PARTICIPATE?

We are intentional about the artists and vendors featured at this event.

There is added emphasis on selection of the following:

- Artists and vendors who are differently abled
- Exhibits that are interactive or have an element of participation, or an activity
- Utilize additional senses, not just sight, but touch, sound, taste and smell.
- Learning opportuities for members of our community to have an experience with a sense removed- from headphones, to eye covers, and more.
- Vendors and businesses that offer additional services of benefit to the differently abled community, from modifications, aids and assistive technologies.
- Creatitiviy, compassion and enthusiasm.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF ARTISTS AND VENDORS?

If selected, our artists and vendors will have the following provided for them:

- predetermined location for set up
- set up time begining at 8am
- depending upon the location, tents will be set up for vendors.

If selected, our artists and vendors will need to provide the following:

- adequate assistance/volunteers for exhibit set up
- staff to be present at all times during the festival
- table, tablecloths, chairs, etc. for display
- adequate assistance/volunteers and ability to break down exhibit no earlier than 2pm, and done by 4pm.

HOW MUCH SUPPORT IS NEEDED?

We hope this festival can become a staple amoung community events. Sustainability comes through support from local businesses, vendors and community patrons.
