12/01/23 Opening Reception at City Hall with student performances (6-8pm)

<u>STIPEND</u> Through a partnership grant with the Florida Division of Arts and Culture and the National Endowment for the Arts, COCA will be able to provide a stipend to each participating art teacher. Stipends are expected to be between \$100 - \$200, depending on how many teachers participate. Payments will be made via check and mailed out following the close of exhibition.

<u>ARTWORK ELIGIBILITY</u> This is an exhibition for K-12 students which means something that might be appropriate for high schoolers may not be as appropriate for kindergartners. This show has to be viewer friendly for ALL participants. No nudity, religious subject matter, or other content deemed not appropriate for young children will be accepted.

<u>FRAMING</u> All artworks must be framed and ready to hang with wire in place on the back of the frame. Wire must be at least 6" long to fit over the Walker System hanging bracket. No sawtooth hangers are allowed. COCA will not re-frame, re-mat or repair artworks. Any artwork arriving damaged or improperly framed will not be accepted. Entries must not exceed 4 feet in any direction (including frame).

<u>ARTWORK DROP OFF</u> All artworks must be hand-delivered to COCA, framed and ready to hang, between Nov 1st and Nov 22nd. All artworks must be labelled on the back with:

Artist Name, Artwork Title, Medium, School, and Teacher Contact

<u>AWARDS</u> This is a juried exhibition. A guest juror will select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for Middle School and High School students and three Honorable Mentions. The Mayor selects one piece for the Mayor's Award, and Amanda Karioth Thompson selects Amanda's Choice Award.
