I have been a Tallahassee resident since 2011 when I moved up from Tampa, FL to pursue an undergraduate degree in music at Florida State University (FSU). I fell in love with the city and, as a result of working part-time at the Warren D. Allen Music Library (AML) as a student, I also fell in love with librarianship. After completing my BA in Music in 2015, I went on to pursue a full-time career in libraries and am now the current Music Digital Services and Special Collections Librarian at the Allen Music Library at FSU. While working full-time, I also pursued two Master's degrees - one in Library Science and the other in Musicology. As both a librarian and a musicologist, I am dedicated to service of my community and creating access and literacy wherever possible. I accomplish these goals by engaging with patrons and employees through social media and in-person events, critically assessing the library's collection and description of its holdings, and maintaining an environment that welcomes questions and curiosity. At work I have created two main projects that bring together the College of Music community and the Tallahassee music community at large. In 2019, I started the College of Music Involvement Fair in which I coordinated a fair for music-related campus organizations to connect with potential members and promote their activities. I led the fair until 2023 when I was able to pass the event on to a newly created department in the College of Music, the Office of Student Success. In February 2024, my colleagues and I received approval from the Dean of the College of Music to go ahead with a new initiative we call the Tallahassee Regional Music Collection. This project is a collaboration between the Allen Music Library and the Center for Music of the Americas to preserve and make accessible recorded audio, artifacts, and more created by artists who have ties to the Tallahassee region. While we are still in the beginning stages, we anticipate the project to eventually extend beyond the confines of FSU. If selected for this position, I would bring an eye for detail, a collaborative spirit, and relevant community engagement experience in the Tallahassee musical community, especially the barbershop singing community. I have been an interim director for the Capital Chordsmen Barbershop Chorus and founded and directed the Barbershop Ladies of Tallahassee (BLT) women's barbershop chorus for five years before the pandemic. Once singing was safer to do, I continued to sing in quartets and collaborate with the Capital Chordsmen. While my work has necessarily drawn me to the Tallahassee music scene, I am excited about the possibility of connecting broadly across the arts community by working on the COCA board. Outside of community music-making, I have served on the board of the Friends of the State Library and Archives of Florida where I gained valuable insight into how a community board can support and promote the needs of an organization. I have also served on the national board of the Music Library Association, where I helped make high-level decisions about the budget, various organizational initiatives, and policies. Because of this experience, I hope to serve the Tallahassee community further by joining the COCA board.
